You are being asked to be a witness for the individual whose name is listed at the top of the **Presence Statement**. The information you provide on the form may help prove that this individual was present at one of the areas affected by the 9/11 attacks.

Please complete the Presence Statement in its entirety, being sure to answer all of the questions. Please be as detailed as possible about specific locations and activities in which you witnessed the claimant. Submitting vague answers such as, "I saw her there," or "He told me he was there," or referring to the entire date range from 9/11/2001 - 5/30/2002, may cause the claim to be denied.

The location "Ground Zero" has many meanings for people. It is very important that you state the specific locations, such as street addresses, cross streets, or landmarks, where you witnessed the claimant. Please refer to the below map to identify the specific locations where you witnessed the claimant, and be sure state the specific locations when completing the form. You may also mark the map with a pen to pinpoint your exact location.


