

You are being asked to be a witness for the individual whose name is listed at the top of the Presence Statement. The information you provide on the form may help prove that this individual was present at one of the areas affected by the 9/11 attacks.

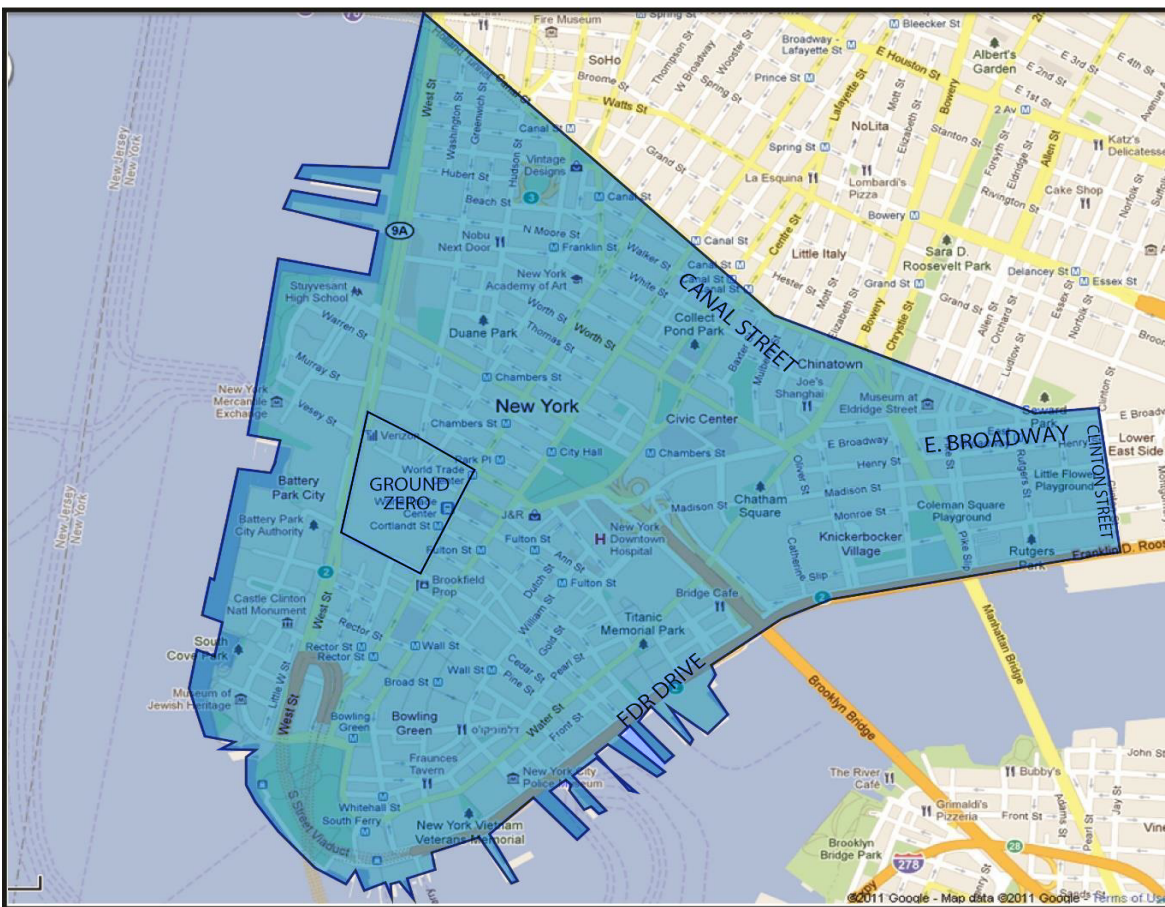
Please complete the Presence Statement in its entirety, being sure to answer all of the questions. Please be as detailed as possible about specific locations and activities in which you witnessed the claimant. Submitting vague answers such as, "I saw her there," or "He told me he was there," or referring to the entire date range from 9/11/2001 – 5/30/2002, may cause the claim to be denied.

The location "Ground Zero" has many meanings for people. It is very important that you state the specific locations, such as street addresses, cross streets, or landmarks, where you witnessed the claimant. Please refer to the below map to identify the specific locations where you witnessed the claimant, and be sure state the specific locations when completing the form. You may also mark the map with a pen to pinpoint your exact location.

3. Between September 11, 2001, and May 30, 2002, where was the victim present?

- ☐ **At the site where the World Trade Center once stood and the surrounding area** (see page 2 of the Instructions for a definition of the surrounding area and a map);
- ☐ **On routes through New York City that were used to remove debris from the World Trade Center site or the Fresh Kills Landfill in Staten Island;**
- ☐ **The Pentagon crash site; or**
- ☐ **The Shanksville, Pennsylvania crash site.**

4. How do you know that the victim was present at the site(s) you checked above?
- ☐ I saw him or her there (eyewitness); or
- ☐ I know that he or she was there but did not see him or her there (not an eyewitness).
5. **What was the victim doing in the area?** For example, did he or she participate in the rescue, recovery, or clean-up efforts? If so, what activities did they perform? Was the victim's office located there? Did he or she live or go to school in the area? Be specific and include as many details as possible in describing the victim's activities in the area. If the victim was in more than one area, please describe the victim's activities in each area separately.
6. **At what specific address was the victim present?** If you don't know the exact address, what were the cross streets or the closest landmark? If the victim was at more than one address, please list all of the addresses, cross streets, or landmarks where the victim was present.
7. **On what specific dates was the victim present in the area?** If the victim was there more than once, list all the dates you can personally remember when he or she was there. If you don't remember the exact dates, try to remember the months or the seasons. If the victim was at more than one site, please list the dates for each site separately.

8. **Do you have any documents or other evidence that support your statements above? Do you have documents that show that the victim was in the area? Are you aware of documents that might exist that support your statements? If so, please describe them.** If you have such documents, you may submit them with this form. If you are aware of documents, please provide as much information as possible about where such documents might be found (including contact names, addresses, and/or telephone numbers).
9. **Answer this question only if you personally saw the victim in the area (eyewitness). If you were not an eyewitness, please go to question 10:** Please describe what you were doing there and what brought you in contact with the victim. For example, were you working with the victim in the area? Did you live with the victim in the area? Did you drop the victim off in the area? Be specific and include as many details as possible, including sights, sounds, and smells. If you have documents that support your statements about what you were doing in the area, please attach them or provide information about where such documents might be located.
10. **Answer this question only if you did not personally see the victim in the area, but know that the victim was there (not an eyewitness):** How do you know that the victim was in the area? Did the victim tell you s/he was in the area, or did someone else tell you the victim was in the area? When did they tell you? Please describe.

11. Is there any other information you think the VCF should know about where the victim was located, or when and why he or she was there? If so, please include the details below and explain how you know the information.
